



# Vaccination Requirements for Kenneling

Cats: Standard annual vaccinations (Within 12 months) and Rabies.

Dogs: Annual 5-in-1/DHPPi (within prior 12 months), Rabies (within prior 3 years) and KENNEL COUGH (See below) vaccinations up to date and cover the boarding period.

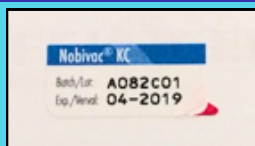
**\*\*Please note that the KENNEL COUGH vaccination is not included in the standard annual vaccinations and must be specifically requested at the vet.**

Please see below our policy regarding the different types of Kennel Cough vaccines and each of the specific requirements for each. Accommodation will be refused if incorrectly vaccinated or not in the correct time frames for the specific vaccine.

## Requirements for the different Kennel Cough Vaccines:

### Intra-nasal vaccine type:

#### Nobivac KC

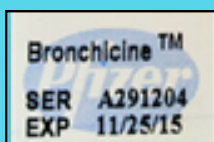


Primary vaccination:  
1 dose no less than 72 hours prior to boarding

Reinforcement:  
1 annual dose

### Injectable vaccine type:

#### Bronchicine



Primary vaccination/Expired (older than 12 months):  
2 Doses must be administered, 2 - 4 weeks apart.

Reinforcement:  
1 annual dose

### Injectable vaccine type:

#### Nobivac Respira Bb



Primary vaccination:  
Two vaccinations with an interval of 4 weeks.

Re-vaccination:  
A single vaccination, administered 7 months after the primary vaccination.

Thereafter, a single vaccination should be administered, annually. In case re-vaccination at 7 months is missed, a single vaccination within 12 months after primary vaccination is sufficient to extend protection against Bordetella bronchiseptica for another year.
